D. 1924, in Order Record No. 11, Page 517, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:
 Name of Appropriator: Joe Thompson, Jr. Livestock Co.; Postoffice Address: Bondurant, Wyoming;
 Amount of Appropriation: 1.450 cu. ft. per sec.; Date of Appropriation: July 23, 1926; Description of land to be irrigated and for which this appropriation is determined and established; Total Acreage: 1450 acre-feet.

Whereas the proof of construction sets forth that said reservoir has been completed in accordance with the terms of said permit to a capacity sufficient to impound 1450 acre feet of water; and that the source of the quantity of water authorized to be stored in the Elkhorn Reservoir to meet the legal water requirements of dependent secondary permits, is obtained from Little Sandy Creek, tributary of Big Sandy Creek on which the reservoir is located,

The right to annually divert and store water is limited to such an amount as shall be beneficially used by and under the authority of dependent secondary permits, not to exceed one filling annually of said reservoir of 1450 acre-feet, for irrigation and stock purposes.
