		SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPLY:	The total amount of water that may be used under the combined appropriations shall be the minimum amount required for the irrigation of said lands and shall not exceed the statutory limit of one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres irrigated.												

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation ----- and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot of water per second for each seventy acres of land for which the appropriation is herein determined and established, except when there is surplus water in the stream as provided by Sections 41-181 to 41-189, Wyoming Statutes, 1957.
