AND FOR CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND MEANS OF CONVEYANCE OF ALL OF ABOVE DESCRIBED APPROPRIATIONS TO THE G. & E. SPRINKLER SYSTEM.

FINDINGS AND ORDER

THIS MATTER coming regularly before the State Board of Control this 26th day of November, 1966, the Board FINDS:

1. That the G. & E. Livestock, Inc., by Gaston Erramouspe, its President, acting pursuant to authorization by its Board of Directors, as evidenced by certified copy of resolution marked "Exhibit A", sets forth under oath that it is the sole owner of all the lands described in the petition, and the appropriations of water attached thereto, as evidenced by Certificate of the County Clerk of Sublette County, Wyoming, which accompanies the petition.
2. That the officers and agents of the G. & E. Livestock, Inc., discovered errors in the description of the lands actually irrigated after the filing of a petition for abandonment of water rights for certain lands owned by G. & E. Livestock, Inc., by the Bureau of Reclamation, Department of the Interior, United States of America, but they or their agents do not know how they occurred as they had nothing to do with the original appropriation.
3. Sometime prior to May 31, 1966, the Bureau of Reclamation agreed to defer resolution of the abandonment proceedings insofar as they referred to G. & E. Livestock, Inc. lands to afford Mr. Gaston Erramouspe opportunity to file petitions with the State Board of Control to accommodate their present sprinkler irrigation methods, providing the Bureau was given opportunity to review such changes and engineering data. On May 3, 1966, the Petitioner and the Bureau of Reclamation agreed that the owner shall not divert water from more than four points of diversion at any one time and that the amount diverted at any one time shall not exceed the amount permitted by law for all of said water rights. However, no formal stipulation was entered into.
4. The Certificates of Appropriation of record covering the appropriations listed in the heading of this Order describe the lands to be irrigated under said appropriations as follows:
