

ORDER RECORD NO. 17-STATE BOARD OF CONTROL

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, BUREAU FOUR, DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT OR PARTIAL ABANDONMENT OF STATES OF ANDERSON, FOR DECLARATION OF FROM BIG SANDY RIVER AND LITTLE SANDY CREEK, INCLUDING:

TWO APPROPRIATIONS OF WATER FROM LITTLE SANDY CREEK, INCLUDING:
SANDY RIVER, THROUGH ENLARGEMENTS OF CONTINENTAL DIVIDE DITCH, UNDER
PERMIT NO. 1422 EEL. AND PERMIT NO. 2140 EEL, WITH FILERITES OF
USE OF PROSPECT 7, 1905 AND DECREE 17, 1909, RESPECTIVELY, AND RIGHT FOR
OF LANDS UNDER PERMIT NO. 1422 EEL, RESPECTIVELY, AND RIGHT FOR
DECREE 17, 1909 (O. R. 4, P. 225; O. R. 5, P. 177; O. R. 6, P. 436;
C. R. 29, P. 5; C. R. 37, P. 462; C. R. 29, P. 5; P. 211; PROOF 9343;
14073, 14075).
THEREAFTER, BY STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY THE BUREAU OF
RECLAMATION, DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND
HELEN MARIE JUEL, ET AL. IT WAS AGREED THAT THE QUANTITY OF THE ABOVE
SECOND FLOW WATER RIGHTS BE REDUCED TO 2.50 CUBIC FEET OF WATER PER
SECOND AND JUEL SHOULD FILE AN ALLOCATION AND APPORTIONMENT OF WATER
AMOUNT OF WATER.

THIS MATTER of the Allocation and Apportionment coming regularly before the State Board of Control this 27th day of November, 1966, the Board FINDS:

FINDINGS AND ORDER

1. That two petitions for declaration of abandonment or partial abandonment or twenty-four appropriations of water from Big Sandy River, were filed with the State Board of Control by the United States Bureau of Reclamation acting through Frank M. Clinton, Regional Director, Region 4, on November 27, 1966. These petitions were considered at subsequent regular meetings. Later a hearing was held by the Superintendent of Water Division No. 4 on part of the appropriations from Big Sandy River. On May 12, 1966 final action was taken on two appropriations from Big Sandy River, but since other contests were then included in Stipulations between the Contestant and the Owners of the lands involved, the Board set the date of April 10, 1967 for submission to the Board of statements of apportionment and allocation of the remaining appropriations under said Stipulations. Further action in the matter was postponed and the Board requested that all allocations under the Stipulations be filed by May 10, 1967, which later was extended.

2. That on February 7, 1966, a Stipulation and Agreement was made and entered into between the Contestant, the Bureau of Reclamation, Department of the Interior, United States of America, and the Contestant, Helen Marie Juel, et al. by which a compromise agreement was reached concerning the water appropriations from Little Sandy Creek through Enlargements of the Continental Divide Ditch under Permit No. 1422 EEL, as adjudicated to

Priority of December 17, 1909 (O. R. 4, P. 225; O. R. 5, P. 177; C. R. 37, P. 462; Proof 14075), as adjudicated to Rose Juel, Helen Creek Land & Livestock Company, with Priority of September 7, 1905 (O. R. 4, P. 225; C. R. 29, P. 5; Proof 9343) and Permit No. 2140 EEL, with their Allocation and Apportionment of the remaining 2.5 cubic feet of water per second under the two appropriations of water from Little Sandy Creek under

Permit Nos. 1422 EEL and 2140 EEL, described in this Order, pursuant to the Stipulation of February 7, 1966.

THE BOARD, now being advised by the records of the Office of the State Board of Control, the Stipulation of February 7, 1966, and the Allocation and Apportionment of July 3, 1966, THEREFORE ORDERS:
