

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, BEING FOR ABANDONMENT OF THE INTERIOR, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT OF PARTIAL ABANDONMENT OF CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS OF WATER FROM BIG SANDY RIVER AND LITTLE SANDY CREEK, INCLUDING:

TWO APPROPRIATIONS OF WATER FROM LITTLE SANDY CREEK, THIRTEENTH PERMIT NO. 1422 ENL. AND PERMIT NO. 2140 ENL., WITH PRIORITIES OF SEPTEMBER 7, 1905 AND DECEMBER 17, 1905, WITH PRIORITIES OF USE OF PROSPECT NO. 1, WESPEROIS UNDER PERMIT NO. 1675, AND HIS OF LANDS UNDER PERMIT NO. 2140 ENL. - 167 ACRES-FEET, WITH PRIORITY OF DECEMBER 17, 1905 (O. R. 4, P. 225; C. R. 29, P. 5; PROOF 9343) AND PERMIT FOR C. R. 29, P. 5; C. R. 37, P. 460, 462; A. C. R. 44, P. 210; PROOF 9343.

THIRTEENTH, BY STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND HELEN MARIE JUEL, ET AL., IT WAS ORDERED THAT THE QUANTITY OF SECOND AND JUEL RIGHTS BE REDUCED TO 2.50 CUBIC FEET OF WATER PER AMOUNT OF WATER.

1966, the Board finds:

FINDINGS AND ORDER

1. That two petitions for declaration of abandonment or partial abandonment of twenty-four appropriations of water from Big Sandy River, and twenty-four appropriations of water from Big Sandy River, were filed with the State Board of Control this 27th day of November, Board at the November, 1964 meeting, and were postponed as incomplete. They were again considered at subsequent regular meetings. Later a hearing was held by the Superintendent of Water Division No. 4 on part of the appropriations from Big Sandy River. On May 12, 1966 final action was taken on two appropriations date of April 10, 1967 for submission to the Board of statements of appropriation and the owners of the lands involved. The Board set the further action in the matter was postponed and the Board requested that all allocations under the stipulations be filed by May 10, 1967, which later was extended.

2. That on February 7, 1966, a Stipulation and Agreement was made and entered into between the Contestant, the Bureau of Reclamation, Department of the Interior, United States of America, and the Contestee, Helen Marie Juel, et al., by which a compromise agreement was reached concerning the water appropriations from Little Sandy Creek through Enlargements of the Continental Divide Ditch under Permit No. 1422 ENL., as adjudicated to priority of December 17, 1905 (O. R. 4, P. 225; C. R. 29, P. 5; PROOF 9343) and Permit No. 2140 ENL., as adjudicated to Rose Juel.

3. That on July 3, 1966, Helen Marie Juel, Margaret Juel Ray, Davis Juel, and Alice Juel, filed with the State Board of Control their Allocation and Apportionment of the remaining 2.5 cubic feet of water per second under the two appropriations of water from Little Sandy Creek under Permit No. 1422 ENL. and 2140 ENL., described in this Order, pursuant to the Stipulation of February 7, 1966.

THE ORDER, now being advised by the records of the Office of the State Board of Control, the Stipulation of February 7, 1966, and the Allocation and Apportionment of July 3, 1966, THEREFORE ORDER:
