WHEREAS, Boulder Irrigation District has presented to the State Board of Control of the State of Wyoming, proof of construction of the Ward Ball Reservoir, Permit No. 6802 Res., located in SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ , Section 14, SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 22, T. 32 N., R. 108 W., Sublette County, Wyoming; and

Whereas, the proof of construction sets forth that said reservoir has been completed in accordance with the terms of said permit to a capacity sufficient to impound 315.26 acre-feet of water; and that the source of the quantity of water authorized to be stored in the Ward Ball Reservoir is obtained from Ward Ball Draw, Tributary New Fork River, Tributary Green River on which the reservoir is located, ~~and~~ through the ~~Ward Ball~~ Ward Ball Draw, Tributary Green River

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Board of Control, under the provisions of the Statutes of Wyoming, has by an order duly made and entered on the 8th day of August, A. D. 19 69, in Order Record No. 18, Page 44, determined the priority and capacity of said reservoir as follows:

Name of Owner Boulder Irrigation District; Address Boulder

Date of Priority August 4, 1965; Total available storage capacity in the Ward Ball Reservoir, as constructed under provisions of Permit No. 6802 Res., is 315.26 acre-feet.

The right to store water is limited to such an amount as shall be beneficially used, not to exceed one filling annually of said reservoir, for irrigation ~~use~~
