Whereas, the proof of construction sets forth that said reservoir has been completed in accordance with the terms of said permit to a capacity sufficient to impound 1.93-acre-feet of water; and that the source of the quantity of water authorized to be stored in the Rye Grass #220 Stock

Reservoir is obtained from Wall Draw, tributary Rye Grass Draw, tributary Onion Creek, tributary Horse Creek, tributary Green River on which the reservoir is located, and through the

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Board of Control, under the provisions of the Statutes of Wyoming, has by an order duly made and entered on the 29th day of May, A. D. 19 80, in Order Record No. 23, Page 533, determined the priority and capacity of said reservoir as follows:

Name of Owner Bureau of Land Management U. S. Department of the Interior, ; Address Box 768, Pinedale, 82941, Wyoming;

Date of Priority September 3, 1974 ; Total available storage capacity in the Rye Grass #220 Stock Reservoir, as constructed under provisions of Permit No. 7904 Stk. Res., is 1.93-acre-feet.

The right to store water is limited to such an amount as shall be beneficially used, not to exceed one filling annually of said reservoir, for stock use.
