

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION FOR VOLUNTARY ABANDONMENT OF PART OF THE MARTIN T. BRUNT)
APPROPRIATION, PERMIT NO. 1484 ENL., DIVERTING FROM THE NEW FORK RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF) DOCKET NUMBER IV-80-3-1
THE GREEN RIVER, THROUGH THE ENLARGEMENT OF THE POSTAL DITCH, WITH A PRIORITY OF) IN WATER DIVISION NUMBER FOUR

This matter was considered by the State Board of Control on November 27, 1906, with the following results:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. THAT the petitioners are owners of the appropriation involved, as evidenced by a Certificate of Ownership from the County Clerk of Sublette County, Wyoming.

2. THAT the appropriation involved is the Martin T. Brunt appropriation, Permit No. 1484 Enl., adjudicated under Proof No. 7787, diverting from the New Fork River, which is a tributary of the Green River through the enlargement of the Postal Ditch, with a priority of January 5, 1906; and of record in Order Record 4, page 4; Certificate Record 25, page 101, describing the lands irrigated as follows:

Township 32 North, Range 108 West	
Section 31: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	25.0 acres
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	20.0
Total	45.0 acres (0.64 c.f.s.)

3. THAT the petitioner requested voluntary abandonment of 14 acres of the Martin T. Brunt appropriation, as the acreage lies above a county road and is not needed for irrigation. The land is sought to be abandoned as follows:

Township 32 North, Range 108 West	
Section 31: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	14.0 acres
Total	14.0 acres (0.20 c.f.s.)

The remainder of the Martin T. Brunt appropriation is unaffected by this petition.

4. THAT the granting of this petition will not injure any other appropriator.
