

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. THAT the Board of Control has jurisdiction both to consider the petitioner's request for detachment (voluntary abandonment) and to prepare and promulgate the order hereinafter set forth disposing of said petition.
2. THAT the Findings of Fact contain the elements necessary to comply with Section 41-3-401, Wyoming Statutes 1977, pertaining to abandonment and the petition should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the 2.5 acres of the John W. Bloom appropriation, 8.6 acre-feet, be detached from the following described lands and that the records on filed in the State Board of Control be noted accordingly.

Township 33 North, Range 109 West  
Section 4: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  2.5 acres


The remainder of the John W. Bloom appropriation is unaffected by this order.
