WHEREAS, ... Eldon E. & Judith A. Marx ... has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation

of water from Green River through the Enlargement Green River Supply Canal for irrigation and stock for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Sublette County, Wyoming.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Board of Control, under the provisions of the Statutes of Wyoming, has, by an order duly made and entered on the 21st day of January A D 19 85 in Order Record No 28 determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation and stock and the right is limited to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot of water per second for each second acre irrigated; for which the appropriation is herein determined and established, except when there is surplus water available under provisions of Sections 41-4-317 thru 41-4-321, Idaho Statutes, 1977.
