

4. THAT the reason for the requested voluntary abandonment is that the lands for which abandonment is sought will be inundated by the construction of Looney Pond Reservoir.
5. THAT a properly prepared map showing the location of the lands for which voluntary is sought accompanied the petition.
6. THAT the petitioners declared their intentions to voluntarily abandon that portion of the William E. Enos appropriation described above and requested that a proper Order of the Board of Control be entered declaring such voluntary abandonment.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. THAT the State Board of Control has jurisdiction both to consider the petitioners' request for voluntary abandonment and to prepare and promulgate the Order hereinafter set forth disposing of said petition.
2. THAT the Findings of Fact contain the elements necessary to comply with Section 41-3-401, W.S. 1977, pertaining to abandonment and the petition should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT this petition be and the same is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the following described portion of the William E. Enos appropriation, Permit No. 3884 Enl., Proof No. 18446 be and the same is ABANDONED:
