This matter was considered by the State Board of Control at its regular meeting on August 20, 1985, with the following results:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. THAT the petitioner is owner of the lands for which the changes of use are requested, as evidenced by a water right deed which accompanied the petition.

2. THAT the appropriations involved are described as follows:

A. The Bette M. and Robert V. Thompson, and Claude A. and Pauline R. Thompson appropriation, Permit No. 8795-11890, adjudicated under Proof No. 30254 in the amount of 15.33 c.f.s. for the irrigation of 1073.0 acres, and as diverting from Cottonwood Creek, a tributary of the Green River, through the Cottonwood Canal, with a priority of December 22, 1908, and of record in Order Record 19, page 386; Certificate Record 71, page 132, describing the lands irrigated as follows:
