

CORPORATION DEED

This indenture made this 4th day of October, 1961, between Bar Cross Land and Livestock Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Wyoming, located at Cora, Sublette County, Wyoming, party of the first part, and Miriam Jenkins Barlow, Helen Jenkins O'Neil and Ruth Jenkins Wilson, parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to it paid by the parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, has given, granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, aliened, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents does give, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien, convey and confirm unto the party of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, to-wit:

Northwest Quarter Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 20; Township 36 North, Range 109 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Wyoming;

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim, or demand whatsoever, of the party of the first part, either in law or equity, either in possession or expectancy of, in and to the above bargained premises and their hereditaments and appurtenances.

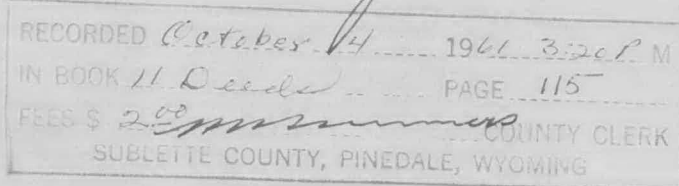
