grantee, of Sublette County and State of Wyoming
the following described real estate, situate in Sublette County and State
of Wyoming, hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State,
to-wit:

A tract of land comprising a portion of Lot Two (2), Section Three (3)
Township Thirty-three (33) North, Range One Hundred Nine (109) West of
the Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming, and bounded and circumscribed by
the following traverse:

Commencing at a point which bears S 89° 50' E. a distance of 666.1 ft.
from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 3, Township 33 North, Range 109 West of
the 6th P. M., thence South a distance of 418 ft.; thence South a distance
of 418 ft. to a point; thence N 89° 41' East, a distance of 618.7 ft. to
a point; thence N 0° 12' W, a distance of 415.2 ft. to a point; thence
S 89° 56' W., a distance of 617.2 ft. to the point of beginning of this
tract and containing 5.910 acres more or less;

and telephone lines.


