 following described real estate situate in the County of Sublette and  
 State of Wyoming, hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and  
 by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of this State, to-wit:

Lots Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block Three (3)  
 of the Feltner Addition to the Town of Pinedale, County of  
 Sublette, State of Wyoming, as the same appear of record  
 on the plat and map thereof appearing of record in the office  
 of the Clerk of Sublette County, Wyoming, together with the  
 buildings and improvements situate thereon or appurtenant thereto,  
 but subject however to the reservations and provisions of  
 United States Patents, and subject further to the real estate  
 mortgage in favor of State Bank of Big Piney, Wyoming,  
 securing payment of Fourteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and no/100  
 (\$14,250.00) Dollars, the deferred balance of which the grantees  
 agree to assume and discharge according to the terms and provisions  
 thereof.


