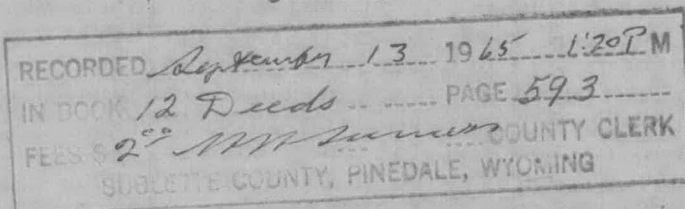
grantee, of Sweetwater County and State of Wyoming

Beginning at the southwest corner of the  $W\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, Township 32 North, Range 108 West of the 6th P.M., Wyoming, thence north 509 feet along a line parallel to the west line of said Section to the point of beginning of this traverse, thence east along a line parallel with the north line of said Section 208 feet to a point, thence South along a line parallel with the west line of said Section, a distance of 104 feet to a point, thence west along a line parallel with the north line of said Section 208 feet to a point, thence north along a line parallel with the west line of said Section a distance of 104 feet to the point of beginning and describing a tract of land 208 feet east and west and 104 feet north and south, containing 50/100 acres, more or less, together with all improvements and appurtenance thereunto appertaining.
