and valuable considerations

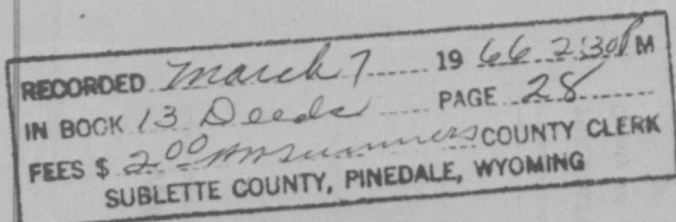
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in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, CONVEY AND WARRANT TO

easements of record or in actual use.



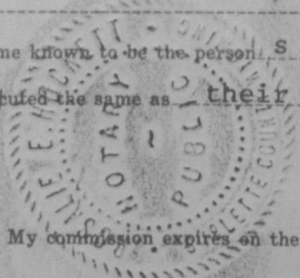
